Biographical Sketch

J. Conrad Dunagan:

Born 31 December 1913, J. Conrad Dunagan graduated from Midland High School and later the University of Texas at Austin. He married and moved to Monahans, Texas, where he managed the Coca-Cola Bottling Company until 1935. He continued his association with Coca-Cola and became Chairman of the Board in 1983.

In addition to his activity in business associations, Dunagan participated in civic organizations throughout the state. He aided the organization of the Monahans State Historic Park and served as president of the Texas State Historical Association, The West Texas Historical Association, and the Permian Historical Association.

Dunagan wrote articles included in the *New Handbook of Texas* and two monographs: *Eugene Holman, A Texan of Distinction*, and *The Holman Hotel: Its owners and Early Monahans*. He aided the founding of the University of Texas of the Permian Basin, endowed a position in the history department and gave generously for the creation and subsequent expansion of the university libraries and archives.

Eugene Holman:

A geologist and oil man born 2 May 1895 in San Angelo, Texas. Eugene Holman grew up in Monahans, Texas where his family operated the Holman Hotel. He attended Simmons College - now Hardin-Simmons - where he took an A.B. degree in 1916. He received an M.A. from the University of Texas at Austin in 1917.

Holman worked for the United States Geological Survey, Humble Oil and Refining Company and in 1945 he was named Chairman of the Board of Executives Jersey Standard.

He also served on the Petroleum Administration for the War Council during World War II. In that capacity, he anonymously sponsored Carl Coke Rister's book entitled *Oil: Titan of the Southwest*.

Carl Coke Rister:

Carl Coke Rister was born in Coke County, Texas, 30 June 1889. He attended Simmons College - now Hardin-Simmons University - where he received a bachelor's degree in 1915. He earned his master's degree (1920) and Ph.D. (1925) from George Washington University. He returned to Hardin-Simmons and later taught history at the University of Oklahoma. While at the university he completed a number of works of history. Among them are: *Border Command: General Phil Sheridan in the West* (1944), *Robert E. Lee in Texas*, (1946), and *Oil: Titan of the Southwest* (1949).

In 1951 he took became Distinguished Professor of History at Texas Technological College - now Texas Tech University - in Lubbock, Texas. There his research and writing continued. Following his death in 1955, Texas tech purchased his collection of papers and books. With a number of ranch collections, they became the core of the Southwest Collection, Special Collections Library.

Scope and Content

The Eugene Holman Collection is made up of correspondence between Carl Coke Rister and Eugene Holman during the years 1939-1951, as well as correspondence relative to J. Conrad Dunagan's research of Eugene Holman, the Holman Hotel, and the Holman house located in Monahans, Texas. There are a variety of newspaper and magazine articles dated 1950-1991. Additionally, there are many photocopies of family photographs. Six photos, two copy prints of Eugene Holman and four photos of the Holman gravesite are contained with in the collection.

Restrictions regarding access

Library and Archive materials must be used in the library reading room. Prior appointment is preferred but not absolutely necessary.

Open for research

No materials within the collection are to be withheld from researchers.
