# **Biographical Sketch**

### Dr. Samuel D. Myres

A native of West Texas and member of a pioneer family, Dr. Myres is a graduate of Southern Methodist University (A. B., A. M.), The University of Texas (Ph. D.), Trinity University (LL.D., hon.), and the University of Geneva, Switzerland (Diplome, Hautes Etudes Internationales). He also holds the diploma from the New York Institute of Photography.

After completing the Ph. D, he was awarded a Social Science research Council fellowship for study in Europe and the Near East. Later, on a fellowship from the Carnegie Endowment, he did research work in South America, particularly in Argentina.

He formerly served as director of the Arnold Foundation in Public Affairs at S. M. U., subsequently becoming professor of government and editor of the Texas Western Press at The University of Texas at El Paso.

Dr. Myres has written numerous books and monographs, especially in history and the social sciences. In recent years, he has devoted much attention to the history and institutions of Texas and the Southwest. The present study is a result of this continuing interest. ### **Betty Orbeck**

A native Texan, Betty began her career in history when she moved from Austin to Odessa in 1951. She worked as a research assistant for Dr. Samuel Myres helping him compile an exhaustive collection of photographs, interviews and materials used in writing his book *The Permian Basin*.

After working for Dr. Myres, Betty joined the staff of The Petroleum Museum in 1976 where she would serve as the Director of Archives for 25 years. During her tenure at the museum, Betty developed an extensive collection of petroleum history and manuscript materials. She received her archival training in Washington D. C. where she attended the archival training course offered by the National Archives

Mrs. Orbeck was also a founding member of many local history organizations like the local chapter of the Daughters of the American Revolution and the Permian Historical Society. She received many awards in recognition of her service in the preservation of local history. She died on December 29, 2004

### **Scope and Content**

This collection contains oral history tapes, oral history transcripts, and biographical information files, county history files, and newspaper clippings, copies of magazine articles from prominent oil and gas journals, copies of thesis, maps and drilling contracts. These documents cover the history of the Permian Basin and more specifically the petroleum industry in this area with focus on major people involved in the development of the Permian Basin oil industry.

These files were used as research for writing Dr. Myres' two book series *The Permian Basin*. There are also copies (handwritten and typed) of the manuscript for *The Permian Basin*. At this time this material is unprocessed.
