

Peggy C. Worthington 1952 – 2019 Inducted 2025

Peggy Worthington, born in 1952, was a trailblazer among petroleum landmen in the Permian Basin. She began her career in the 1970s after graduating from Arkansas State University, eventually becoming Vice President of Land and Business Development at Bold Energy, LLC, where she oversaw the acquisition of over 62,000 net acres across Texas and New Mexico. Worthington was known for her negotiation skills, mentoring efforts, and advocacy for women in the petroleum sector. She earned recognition as the 2013 AAPL Landman of the Year and remained dedicated to her profession, continuing to be instrumental in Bold Energy contracts and agreements well past her retirement in 2014. Her influence continues through the many professionals she mentored and the opportunities she created for women in the industry.
