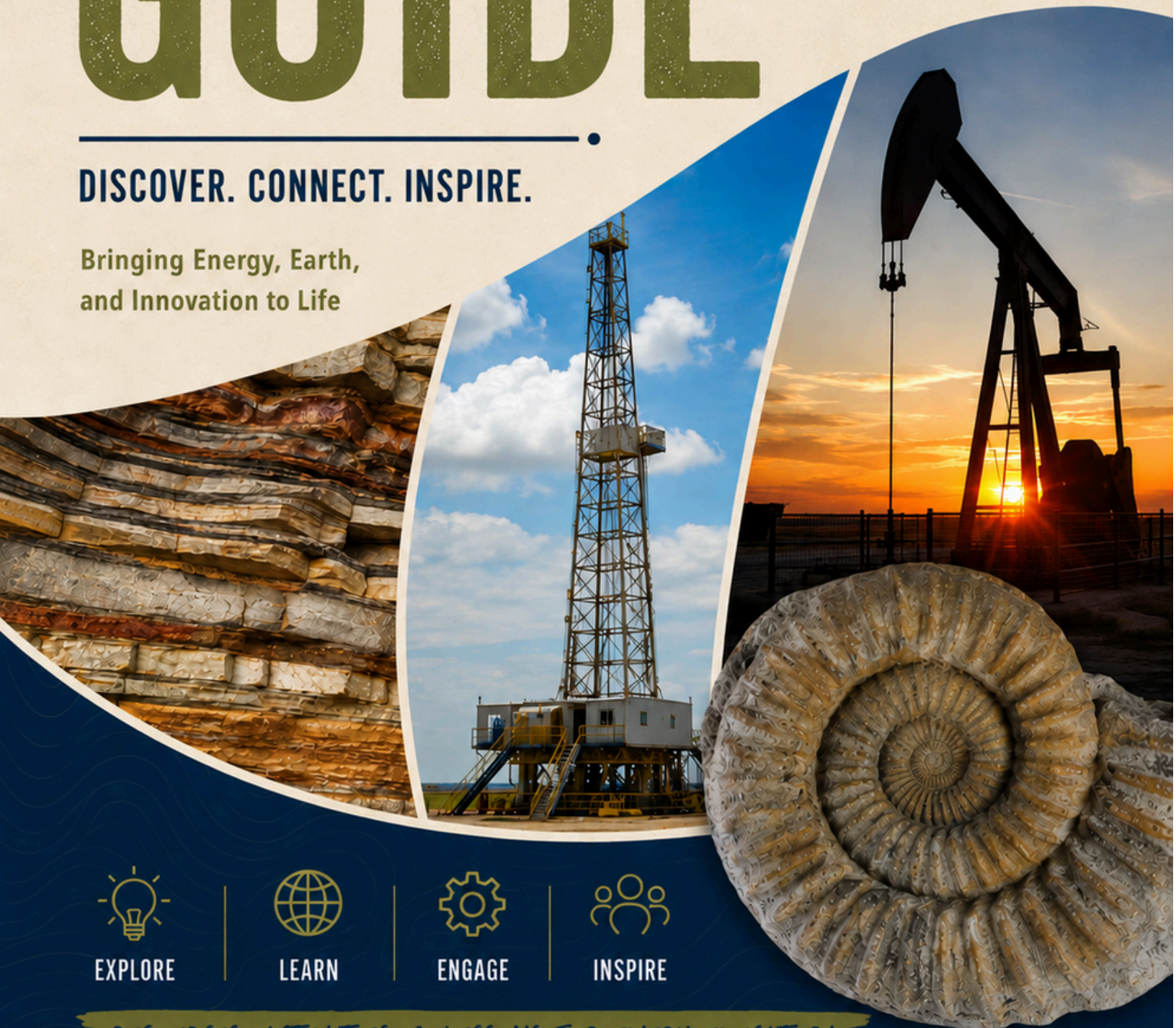

Field Trip Experiences

Museum Etiquette

Students:

- No backpacks, bags, or toys.
- No cell phone use during tours and classes.
- No running or climbing on displays
- Stay with your group, do not wander off.
- Do not touch the artifacts on display.
- No food or drink allowed in the galleries.

Teachers/Chaperones:

- Take a head count.
- Have students divided into groups:
 - 2 groups for a Class & Tour.
 - 3 groups for a Tour only.
- Teachers/Chaperones are responsible for maintaining discipline.
- No phone use during field trips.
- Photography is allowed, but no flash in the galleries.

Pricing:

- **Guided Classes at the Museum** classify as a Field Trip and are fully covered by ExxonMobil.
- **Classes on your campus are:**
 - \$75 for the first hour
 - \$25 for each additional hour
- **Discovery Dome is booked in 2 ways:**
 - **Half Day - \$150**
 - **Full Day - \$250**
 - Discovery Dome requires a large quiet space for set up.
